Membership of the MSG is **informal and open, and determined only by voluntary participation in the designated public and open mailing list:**

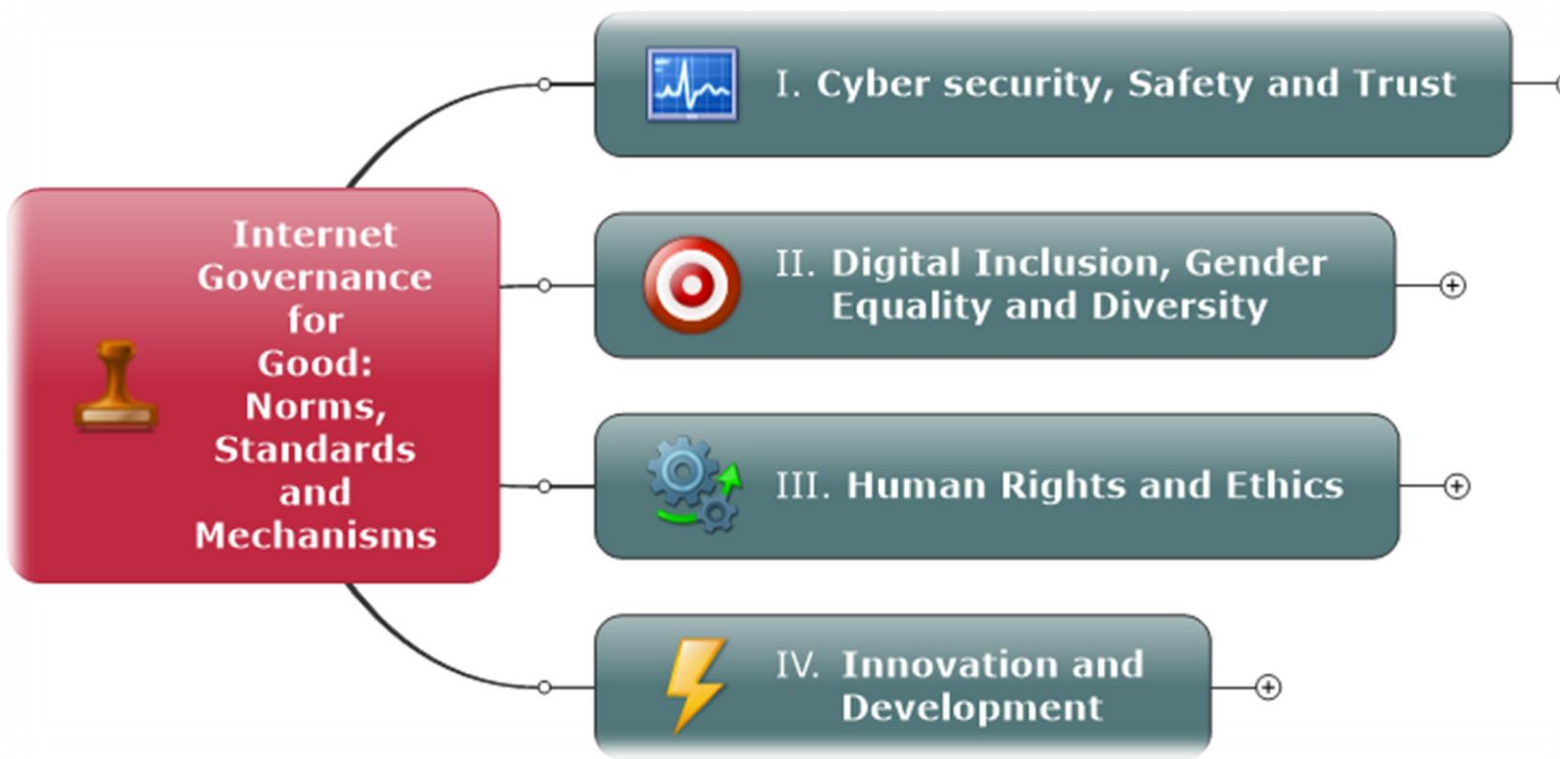

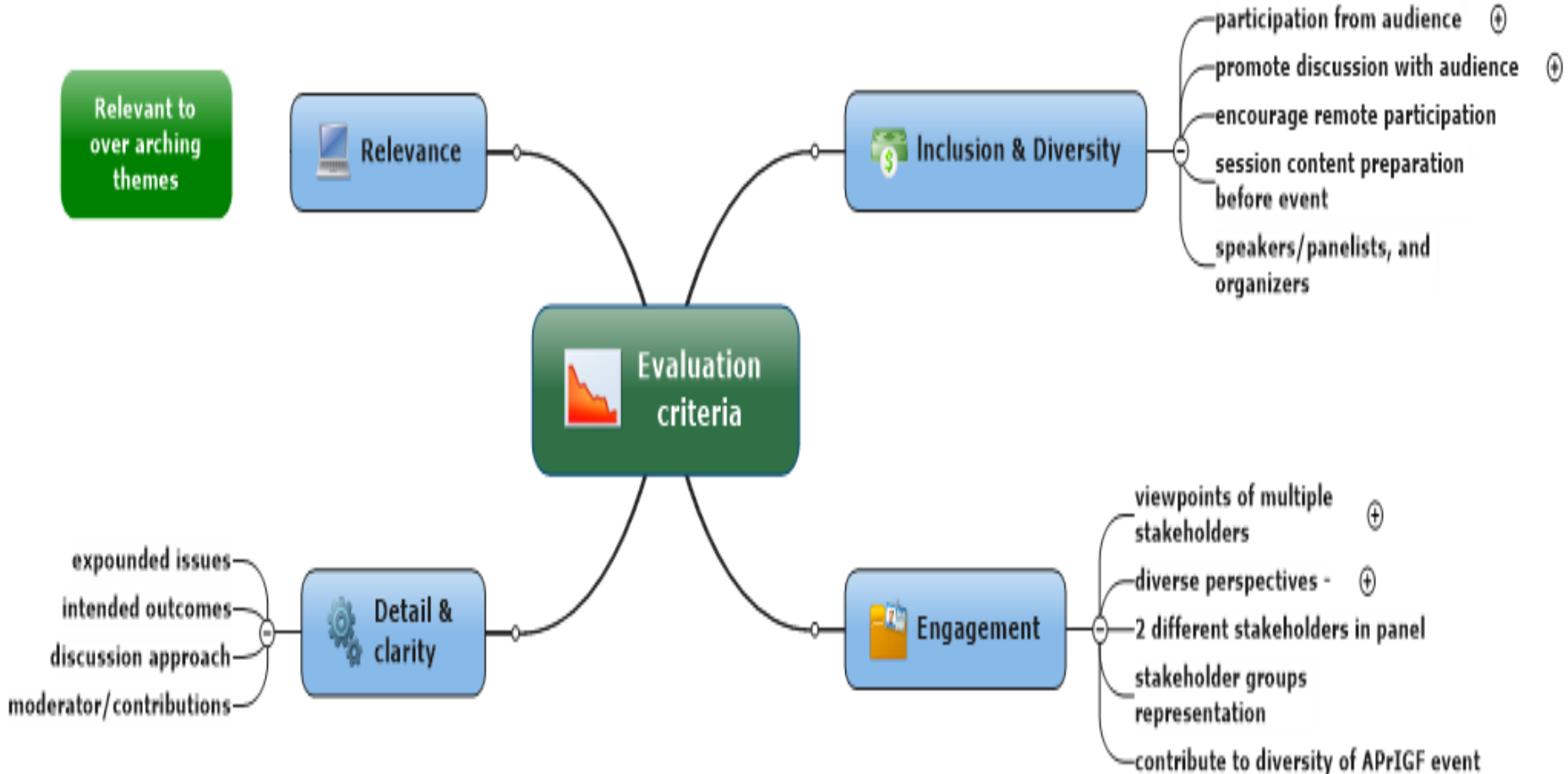
Youth IGF (yIGF)
